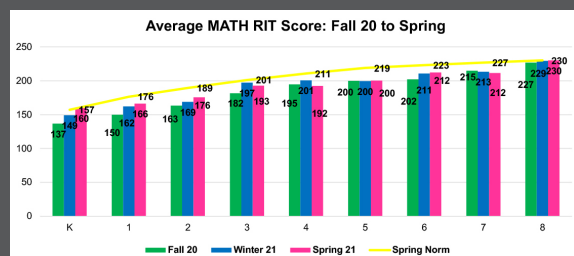
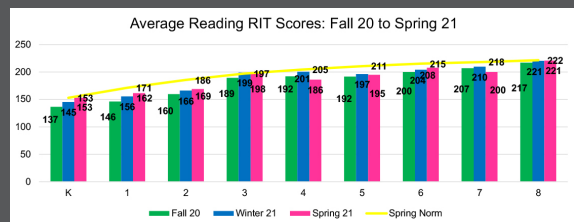
- Our middle school participated in their first online debate with Innovation Academy West located in Cleveland, Ohio
